

## *Descendants of Eva Jawaandasse*

### *Generation No. 1*

1. EVA<sup>1</sup> JAWAANDASSE was born 1656 in pr. South Bank, Mohawk Valley, New York, USA. She married UNKNOWN EUROPEAN MALE.

Notes for EVA JAWAANDASSE:

Eva's Indian name means, "Who has not any too much to eat" according to the English translation of the Dutch name which was translated from Mohawk to Dutch for the minister by Hilltje (Van Slyke) Van Olinda, a half Mohawk woman who was the translator for New York. Philip Henhaw disagrees with this translation, and indicates that it should be Tsyawennase meaning "New word or voice". The name may at one time have been first among the Astawenserontha Bear Clan, but is not found in the Newhouse Manuscript (see Faux, 2002).

It is likely that Eva's "husband" was a White man, surname unknown at this time. Her grandchildren were apparently very European looking (e.g., Johannes "White Hans" Crine). The only clue as to her spouse is the first name of her son, Noach (probably Noah). This is a very rare name (as is Kryn) and if given for the first name of the father (which seems to have been quite common as in Johannes Kryn's other grandfather Kryn Jansen van Meteren) then it will be important to track down any Noachs who were residing in the vicinity at the time and see who can, and cannot, be ruled out.

She married KRYN ANEQUENDAHONJI, son of KRYN VAN METER and CATHARINE SADIOWAWA. He was born Abt. 1675 in pr. North Bank, Mohawk Valley, New York, USA, and died Aft. 12 Dec 1734.

Notes for ANNA TIOSSEROAGE:

Anna's Indian name at baptism, Tiosseroage means, "Who clings to a dress". Her adult name appears in the Albany Reformed Dutch records as Hazeankehha. Hence Tiosseroage would not have been the name she was known by later in life, although the name given to her 18 year old sister as recorded in the baptismal

records is indeed found among the adult female names of the Astawenserontha Bear Clan noted in Seth Newhouse's 1885 listing. Anna Hazeankehha may be phonetically equivalent (given problems with spelling, and pronouncing Mohawk names - as well as transcription errors) to Thiyihekateh in the Newhouse manuscript.

Notes for KRYN ANEQUENDAHOJJI:  
While the evidence is clear that Crine Anequendahonji was of the Turtle Clan (see Sievertsen, 1999), his Indian name was assumed by his son Johannes Crine Anequendahonji of the Bear Clan sometime after 1734. For some reason the name was "up for grabs" at least by his son so that the Clan affiliation did not apply. Clan and family names are passed on as a group by each lineage to be assigned by the appropriate Clan Matron.

There is no one with a formame of Kryn found in the Albany or Schenectady Reformed Dutch records. The only two potential sources appear to be Cryne "The Great Mohawk" who left Caughnawaga NY to lead a group of Mohawks to Kanawaki Quebec about 1674. Another is Kryn Jansen van Meteren, born in Holland, and the attributed father of Kryn Anaquendahonji. For more details see the entry for Kryn Jansen.

Notes for MARGARET TEKONWANONRONNIH CRINE (GREEN):

Margaret's brother Johannes Schrine (Crine, Green) was known as "White Hans", apparently reflecting his light colouration. It is likely that their mother Anna was a French or English settler captured by the Mohawks. Patrick Campbell, in his diary written in 1792, specifically noted that Margaret's son Captain David Hill was of mixed Mohawk and European ancestry.

Johannes (Hance, Hans, John) was apparently quite fair in complexion and appeared to many as having strong European features. Here are some statements in relation to this matter:

- 1) "Hans Croyne a whitish Indian living at the Mohocks" (1757)
- 2) Most of the documents use the label "White Hans" to refer to Johannes Kryn
- 3) His son John Crine (Green) Aronghyengtha was known as "Blue Eyed Green" in documents pertaining to the War of 1812

It seems clear that Johannes and siblings had a mixture of European and Mohawk on both their mother and their father's sides of the family. The records indicate that both of their grandfathers were European.
